recommended not to leave it more than one day before completing the diary.

- Write down everything you see and hear in as much detail as possible. It may be embarrassing or distressing at times, but it is very important that the association (and the court if necessary) learns exactly what problems you have been experiencing. Include swear words in full rather than "he said ****" or "he shouted abuse at me".
- Do not hold on to this diary for more than one month without discussing it with your housing officer. If the incidents are not too serious complete the diary and return it to the housing officer straight away. The housing officer will photocopy your diary for

your own record. You must report immediately any serious incident of nuisance (e.g. all night disturbance, threats, violence, intimidation, etc.) to your housing officer as well as writing down the incident in your diary.

- Further diaries are available from the Connect Housing if required. If you have any difficulties writing down what has happened or if you have any problems with completing the diary please inform the housing officer who will provide every assistance to you.

Neighbour Nuisance Diaries are too important to get wrong.
