Why do I need your help?

You may need my help because:



- You are having problems at school
- You may be fighting with your parents
- You might be in trouble with the police
- You might have health issues
- You might feel isolated

It could be a number of reasons.

How do you know about me?

You have probably been referred to me by a:
Housing officer

- Or your parent/carer
- Or even a Health Visitor
- It could even be from school.

Where would we meet?

At first it would be at your house, and then if you want, we could meet at school, or a library or even a café. It's your choice – you decide.

What will I have to do?

Nothing you don't want to, however you might need to work with me so that you stay in your house, or stay at school.

All we do is talk and try to find out what problems you are having and how we can work together to try and solve some of them.

How long will I spend with you?

We decide that together, but usually I will see you for half an hour to an hour every other week for about three months.

We won't see each other every day just when we need too.

What if I don't want your help?

That would be up to you and your parents/carers.
